FALL ACADEMIC PROGRAM

- All courses are taught in Spanish at Pontificia Universidad Católica and the Universidad de Chile.
- Minimum course load is 12 semester credit hours. Courses are 3 credit hours unless noted otherwise.
- Students must have completed the equivalent of at least 3 semesters in Spanish (SPA 153).
- Students with the equivalent of 3 semesters of Spanish (SPA 153) are **required** to attend the pre-program language prep course (SPA 195) beginning in June in Buenos Aires, Argentina.
- Students with the equivalent of at least 4 semesters of Spanish (SPA 212+) have the **option** to join the pre-program course in Buenos Aires, SPA 304, which can count as an elective for the Spanish major/minor.
- **Note to POL students:** POL courses taken on this program will not count towards the in-residence requirement. You are encouraged to meet with the Department of Politics and International Affairs for more clarification on this policy.

- It is the student's responsibility to speak to their major and minor advisor(s) regarding their abroad coursework and how (or if) it will count towards their degree plan.
